### **A** Alaska Multi Sport Adventure Trips Featuring Denali, the Kenai, Wrangell St. Elias, the Arctic and More!

Our camping and multi-sport tours have been designed to highlight Alaska's intact ecosystems, abundant wildlife and adventurous day tours located near and within Alaska's national parks and protected areas. We camp at least two nights at most locations, with occasional hotel or cabins thrown in, allowing us time to get to know these areas and to participate in a variety of different sightseeing and adventure tours.

#### **Classic Alaskan Tour (7 Days)**

We'll spend two nights deep in Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, an area known for its beauty and abundant wildlife, camped near one of the many beautiful local lakes. Next we'll explore the glaciers and wildlife in Kenai Fjords National Park. This evening we'll stay at a local hotel. Finally, we'll head north to Denali National Park home of the largest mountain in North America and abundant wildlife.

#### Included Activities

- Canoeing in the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge and near Denali National Park
- Full day bus tour in Denali National Park
- Excellent hiking opportunities throughout

#### **Wildland Glacier Tour (7 Days)**

One of our guide's favorite trips! This off the beaten path trip camps near the base of the Matanuska Glacier providing the opportunity to walk on its immense snout. We'll travel deep within Wrangell St. Elias National Park to experience the area's fascinating human and geological history. Next we're off to explore the temperate rainforest and glaciers near Valdez. A half day scenic ferry trip across Prince William Sound will bring us back to the Kenai Peninsula and Hope, the best preserved gold rush town in South Central Alaska. Please Note: this itinerary may operate in a slightly different order due to changes in ferry schedule and or local conditions. All destinations will be featured, but the order may be altered.

- Walk on Alaska's largest accessible glacier
- Explore the impressive ghost town Kennecott
- Cruise Prince William Sound on a ½ day scenic ferry
- Explore a well preserved gold rush town
- Excellent hiking opportunities throughout

## **Alaska Arctic Adventure (7 Days)**

Our journey brings us across the Yukon River, the Arctic Circle, to the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge and the Arctic Ocean. Excellent remote hiking opportunities throughout.

## **Classic Family Tour (7 Days)**

Finally, we'll spend two nights deep in Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, an area known for its beauty and abundant wildlife, camped near one of the many beautiful local lakes.

## Wildlife Tour (10 Days)

For those with wildlife viewing as a significant objective this trip is our best. We'll visit 4 of Alaska's most wildlife rich environments: Kenai National Wildlife Refuge, Kenai Fjords National Park with its abundant marine wildlife, Denali National Park and its abundant large animals and the Denali Highway region with abundant bird life. Your chance of viewing and photographing wildlife is outstanding at these locations. Look for bears, whales, sea lions, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, fox, Bald Eagles, swans, and lots more. **Please Note:** This itinerary may operate in a slightly different order depending on ferry schedules and local conditions. All destinations of the itinerary will be the same, only the destination order will be altered.

- Full day bus tour in Denali National Park
- Cruise Prince William Sound on a ½ day scenic ferry

7/15 departure will begin with the Classic Alaskan Tour and will follow with the Arctic Adventure Tour. Trip participants will take the train unguided from Denali to Fairbanks on day 7 of the Classic Alaskan Tour and will stay at a Fairbanks hotel (both included in the cost of the trip). Participants will then meet their guide in Fairbanks on day 8 and will travel north to Prudhoe Bay and the Arctic Ocean where the trip will end on day 14. Participants can then fly from Prudhoe Bay (day 14) to the location of their choice (not included in the tour price). Return flights to Fairbanks are approximately \$350 and flights to Anchorage are approximately \$400. Other destinations are available including Barrow, the most northern settlement in the U.S.

7/22 departure will begin with the Classic Alaskan Tour and will follow with the Arctic Adventure Tour. Trip participants will take the train unguided from Denali to Fairbanks on day 7 of the Classic Alaskan Tour and will stay at a Fairbanks hotel (both included in the cost of the trip). Participants will fly to Prudhoe Bay on the morning of day 8 (Not included: budget approximately \$350) to meet their guide in Prudhoe Bay to begin their journey southbound. The trip will end in Fairbanks at approximately 4:00 pm on day 14. Trip participants can continue their trip from here or can return to Anchorage. Flights from Fairbanks to Anchorage are approximately \$150.

7/29 departure will begin with the Arctic Adventure Tour and will follow with the Classic Alaskan Tour. Participants will arrange transport to Prudhoe Bay where the trip will begin on day 1. The Arctic Adventure Tour portion of the trip will end approximately 4:00 pm on day 7 in Fairbanks. Trip participants will need to arrange transport to Anchorage (flights are approximately \$150) in order to meet for the Classic Alaskan Tour by 9:00 am on day 8. Hotel in either Fairbanks or Anchorage are included.

**Glacier/ Arctic Combo (14 Days)**

The Glacier/ Arctic Combo is a combination of the Wildland Glacier Tour and the Arctic Adventure Tour. Not included: internal flights to/ from Anchorage to Prudhoe Bay and/or Fairbanks. Budget approximately \$500. May operate with either itinerary first depending on departure date and trip availability. Hotel is included between trips. Contact us for details.
